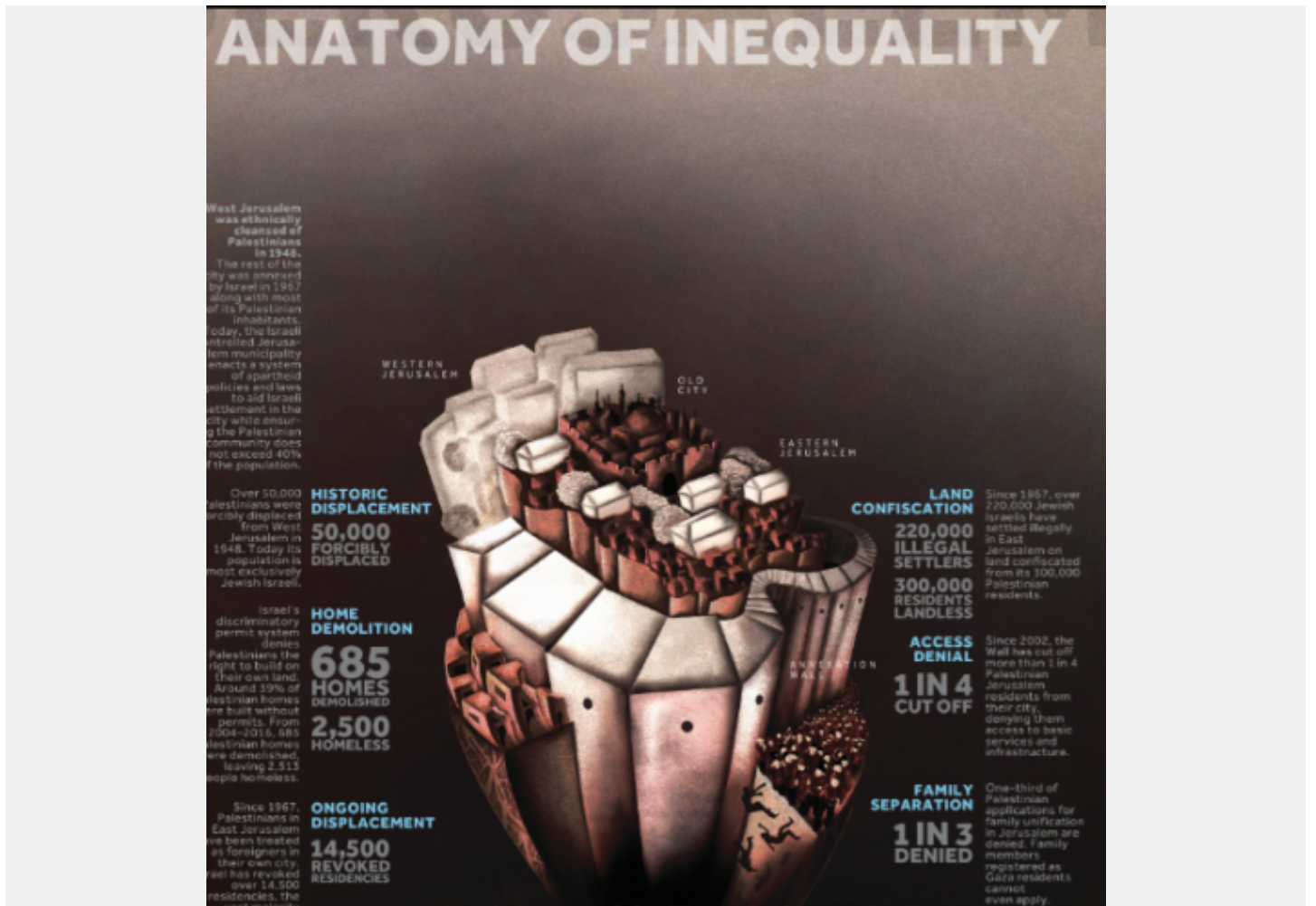

« Les Palestiniens de Jérusalem-Ouest ont subi un nettoyage ethnique en 1948. Le reste de la ville a été

annexé par Israël en 1967 avec la plupart de ses habitants palestiniens. Aujourd'hui, la municipalité de Jérusalem contrôlée par Israël a établi par ses lois et sa politique un système d'apartheid qui soutient la colonisation et dans le but de conserver une majorité démographique. Dans cette optique, la population palestinienne ne devrait pas dépasser 40% de la population totale de la municipalité. »

JERUSALEM ANATOMY OF INEQUALITY

West Jerusalem was ethnically cleansed of Palestinians in 1948.

The rest of the city was annexed by Israel in 1967 along with most of its Palestinian inhabitants. Today, the Israeli controlled Jerusalem municipality enacts a system of apartheid policies and laws to aid Israeli settlement in the city while ensuring the Palestinian community does not exceed 40% of the population.

Over 50,000 Palestinians were forcibly displaced from West Jerusalem in 1948. Today its population is almost exclusively Jewish Israeli.

Israel's discriminatory permit system denies Palestinians the right to build on their own land. Around 39% of Palestinian homes were built without permits. From 2004-2016, 685 Palestinian homes were demolished, leaving 2,513 people homeless.

Since 1967, Palestinians in East Jerusalem have been treated as foreigners in their own city. Israel has revoked over 14,500 residencies, the vast majority since the 'Peace Process' began in 1993.

At least 90,000 refugees and their descendants originally from Jerusalem remain in forced exile today.

Since 1967, over 220,000 Jewish Israelis have settled illegally in East Jerusalem on land confiscated from its 300,000 Palestinian residents.

Since 2002, the Wall has cut off more than 1 in 4 Palestinian Jerusalem residents from their city, denying them access to basic services and infrastructure.

One-third of Palestinian applications for family unification in Jerusalem are denied. Family members registered as Gaza residents cannot even apply.

10,000 Palestinian children have no access to education or basic services as Israel refuses to register them as residents.

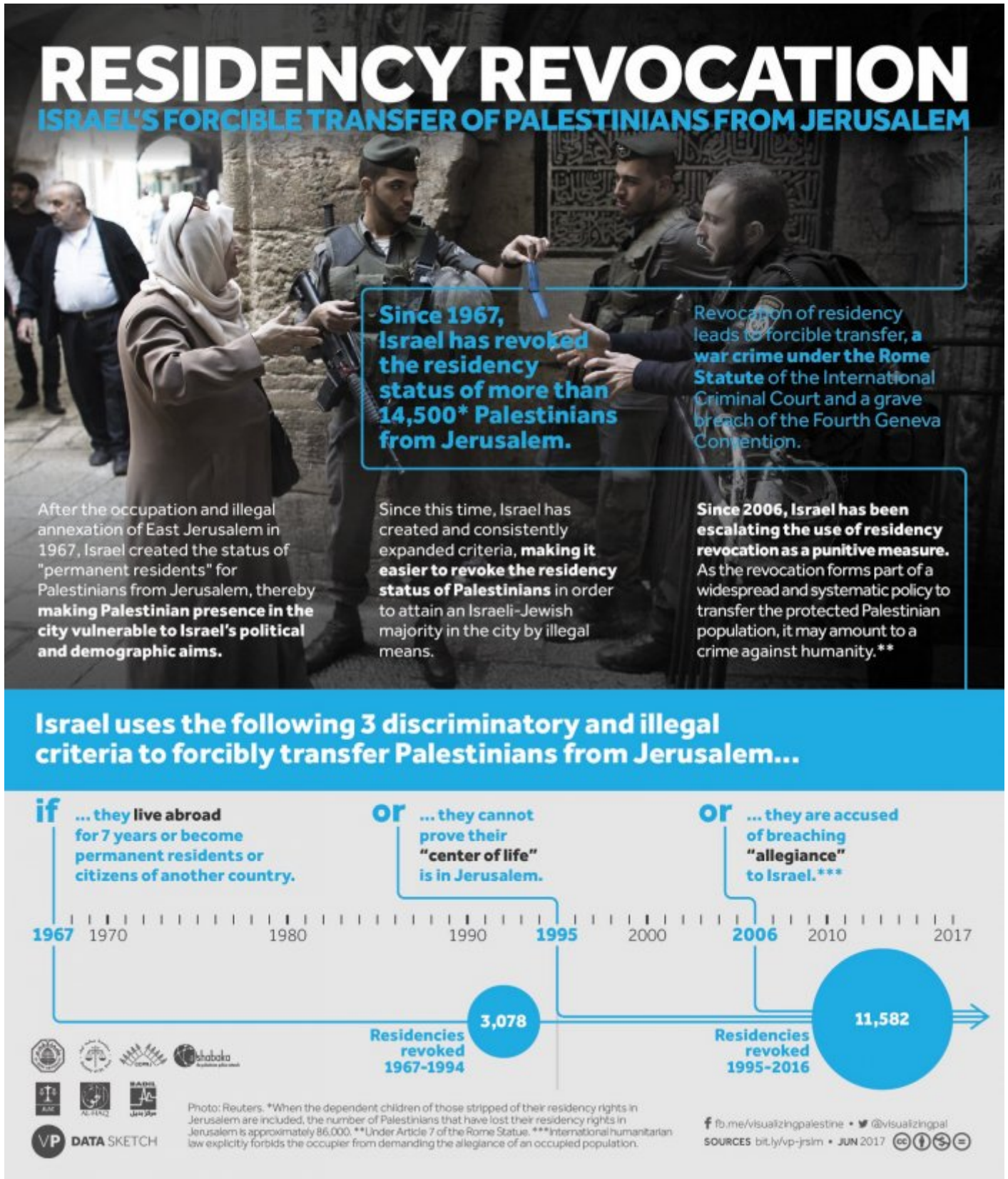

JERUSALEM A CITY FOR ALL?

East Jerusalem was occupied and illegally annexed by Israel in 1967. Today, Israel enacts **APARTHEID POLICIES** aiming to suppress the growth of the **PALESTINIAN COMMUNITY** to **NOT EXCEED 40%** of the population of Jerusalem.
